E-COMMERCE AIR HUB WILMINGTON, OH

Architect: SMDC
Project Type: Industrial

Renovations to a former logistic warehouse to create an "air gateway" and package-sorting facility. This high-profile client required a tight, streamlined schedule and quick turnaround on scope changes. More than one million square feet and \$45 million of work were completed in just nine months.



Project Type: Place of Worship

Renovations to an historic church in downtown Cincinnati. A combined project cost of more than \$6 million, the renovations prepared two different worship spaces for two new organs, and converted the outdoor courtyard into a spiritual garden with a living wall.



GRAETER'S COLUMBUS, OH

Architect: Luminaut Project Type: Retail

At 11,600 SF, this location is the biggest Graeter's retail location yet. Former big-box discount store was converted into a scoop and pastry shop, training center, offices, and a kids play space. The location opened in the Spring, and within days of opening, the play space was booked months out.



THE SEVEN HILLS SCHOOL CINCINNATI, OH

Architect: SHP Design

Project Type: Performing Arts Venue

Top-of-the-line 43,000 SF performing arts venue with auditorium seating for approximately 500 people; wing and fly spaces to support large casts and full-scale scenery; state-of-the-art technology; and more. Project completed while school was in session with minimal disruption.
